*Covenant Child* by Terri Blackstock

After Sherry Holbrooke dies in a car accident, her twin daughters are left to be raised by her wealthy husband Jack. Jack remarries Amanda and the four live happily on their estate. Not long after the marriage, Jack is killed in a plane crash and the twins are sent to live with disadvantaged distant relatives, despite Amanda's efforts to gain custody. After years of failed attempts to contact the girls, Amanda succeeds and is able to give them all the comforts they've longed for.

*Without a Trace* by Colleen Coble

When Bree Nichols's husband and son board a plane, it disappears over Michigan's Upper Peninsula. Bree vows to find out what happened to their plane and accidentally uncovers a violent crime that is linked to the plane's disappearance. Will her investigation tear her tiny community apart?
